* This figure represents 5.25% of a three-year rolling average of the Fair Market Value of the endowment, consistent with accepted prudent practices for endowment management and with the endowment spending policy adopted by the Vestry at the January 2018 meeting.

** Also at its January 2018 meeting, the Vestry approved a deficit budget, planning to meet the shortfall with additional, specially-approved endowment funds. For now, month-to-month deficits have not impacted cash flow, and the treasurer and parish staff continue to monitor the situation closely. The Vestry, with support from the Finance and Stewardship Committees, are working to develop a long-term solution to the underlying challenges.
